MEASUREMENT CONVERSIONS

3 tsp | 1 tbsp

2 tbsp | 1 oz

8 oz | 1 cup

16 oz | 1 pint

32 oz | 1 quart

128 oz | 1 gallon

TIPS

- Always read labels carefully before using any chemical spray.
- Do NOT spray in the heat of the day.
- Water well 24 hours in advance before spraying or wait until after a good rain. This will cleanse the leaves, making them more likely to absorb the chemical.
- Do NOT spray to the point of runoff
- Try to cover the top and the underside of leaves. Penetrate dense foliage to ensure complete coverage.

SOMETHING TO CONSIDER

Consider a SPREADER STICKER to mix in with your spray. This will make all sprays more effective as it allows the spray to stick to leaves. One 8 oz bottle of Gordon's Spreader Sticker makes 24 gallons.
