LIGHT LEVEL

- M- Medium Light: Plants that are in direct exposure from an east or west window or in proximity to a south exposed window.
- L- Low Light: Plants that are placed near north windows or feet away from east and west windows. Low light is commonly found in bath rooms and corners.

WATERING

- D-Drench, soak roots thoroughly then allow soil to dry before watering again.
- F -Frequent water required, but don't allow plant to stand in water.
- W-Daily watering. Plant may stand in water but only for brief periods.
